

Supplies Needed

Cleaning Tools

- Small Pail of warm water (approximately 1 gallon)
- Long Handled Plastic Bristle Scrub Brush
- Cleaning Towel
- Cleaning Sponge
- Scotch-Brite (inside of Compactor only)
- Plastic Scraper (inside of Compactor only)
- Compactor Trash Bags

Cleaning Liquids

- Windex type spray cleaner for outside of compactor
- Mild Detergent (Dish Washing Soap, Dawn, Mr. Clean) for inside of compactor
- Spray Disinfectant





Cleaning Steps

WARNING - DO NOT SPRAY INSIDE OR OUTSIDE OF MACHINE WITH PRESSURIZED WATER


Steps Task

- 1 Mix Detergent and warm water in Small Pail according to detergent manufacturers label directions.
- **2** Open Main Cleanout Door and remove Trash Cart from Compactor.
- **3** Unplug Compactor and roll away from its place of day-to-day use, sweep, and mop area underneath Compactor
- 4 Clean Trash Cart with Cleaning Towel and clean outside of Compactor with water soap solution
- 5 Place New Trash Bag under Main Cleanout Door to prevent water from getting on the floor
- 6 Clean back of Main Cleanout Door and compactor's interior floor area the Trash Cart sets with the water soap solution and dry compactor interior floor.
- 7 Place Trash Bag used under Main Cleanout Door inside the Trash Cart and return trash cart inside the Compactor

- 8 Use Cleaning Brush and water soap solution as needed to wash interior of Compactor. For tough stains, use sponge or brush to thoroughly wet stains and let stand for three (3) minutes, then scrub vigorously with brush or Scotch Brite as necessary. Dry surfaces after washing. Avoid making contact with the 2 rails in the back of the Compactor.

- 10 After washing and drying all side surfaces, remove Compactor Head Cover and drop into Trash Cart NOTE: To remove head cover - pull up and out on handles on head cover and lower head cover into trash cart
- 11 Remove Trash Cart with Compactor Head from Compactor
- 12 Wash Compactor Head with water soap solution in Trash Cart, or take to a large sink. After cleaning re-install the Compactor head cover NOTE: To install Head Cover slide Head Cover over Compactor Head, pull up, and latch handles on Head Cover
- **13** Wipe exterior of Compactor with Cleaning Towel and Windex type surface cleaner
- **14** Spray disinfectant on areas inside Compactor, but avoid directly spraying disinfectant on 2 rails.
- 15 Install Trash Cart in Compactor and close Main Cleanout Door
- **16** Assure your hands are dry and plug Compactor into wall outlet
- 17 If Compactor won't run verify Main Cleanout Door is Closed and Machine Key is turned to run
