Original ecotrash.

Cleaning

WARNING - DO NOT SPRAY INSIDE OR OUTSIDE OF MACHINE WITH PRESSURIZED WATER. Clean like the inside of microwave. Do not use excess water inside.

- 1) Wipe down machine with clean rag or disposable wipe when trays are collected or as machine needs cleaning.
- 2) A full machine cleaning should occur once a week or as often as other trash receptacles.
- 3) Insert key on right of machine.
- 4) Turn key clockwise, push then pull to open door.
- 5) Pull out bin.
- Clean inside and outside of bin with all purpose cleaner.
 Use non-bleach or non-chlorinated products.
- 7) Remove black plastic compactor head cover.
- 8) Place head cover in bin and clean.
- 9) When necessary head cover can be taken to sink and given a more thorough cleaning.
 - Compactor head cover should be cleaned once a week.
- 10) Wipe down inside of machine.
- 11) Insert clean bag then push bin back into machine.
- 12) Place head cover on compactor head.
 - Head cover frontside is notched and labeled "FRONT", backside is flat.
- 13) Shut door.
- 14) Spray outside of machine with all-purpose, non-bleach, non-chlorinated products and wipe with clean towel.
- 15) When cleaning front trash door, turn key counter clockwise to lock into position.
 - This will stop the door from opening and make it easier to clean.
- 16) To clean behind compactor unplug machine and pull away from wall.
- 17) Sweep behind compactor as needed.
- 18) Mop behind compactor.
- 19) Plug compactor in and push back into position.
- 20) Machine LCD Screen should display "READY" when ready for use.
